- Winter league: We will have a Varsity and a Sub-Varsity team. Games will run January 4 through February 22 on Saturday mornings/early afternoons at Foothills Sports Arena. Registration link will be sent out via email in December. Cost to play: TBD
  - **\*\* Cost to play Winter: \$100**
- Winter training and conditioning: Tuesdays and Thursdays, 7:30 to 9:00pm, at Chatfield
- Team levels: One Varsity team, one JV team, one C Level/L3 team
  - **\*\* Goal is 25 players per roster**
- Tryout dates: February 24, 25, and 26 at Foothills Sports Arena (3608 S Kipling St, Denver, CO)
  - Monday, February 24: 7:00–8:30 pm
  - Tuesday, February 25: 8:30–10:00 pm
  - Wednesday, February 26: 9:30–11:00 pm
  - Teams will be announced via player GroupMe the evening of the 26th
- The first practice of the season will take place February 27 at Foothills Sports Arena from 4:30-6:00 pm. Practices will move outdoors for the remainder of the season.
- Practices are Monday through Friday through the end of the season. All levels practice at the same time. Times and locations will be announced as we get closer to the season.

### **Financials and Budget**

- 2024–25 Budget is based on 72 players
- Cost to Play worksheet
- Fees to play
  - **Jeffco Athletic Participation Fee: \$185 per player per sport;** paid to Jeffco and goes into a general athletic fund to be portioned out to all district schools/sports (Chatfield sees very little of this; the funds usually go to facility improvements)
  - **Booster Club Fee: \$385 per player** (paid to the Booster Club)
    - **\*\* Raise Your Spirits Fundraiser - briefly discussed the plan**
      - *Participation is optional*
      - *Player Family provides at least 1-2 bottle of alcohol (\$50 value)*
      - *Player Family sells raffle tickets at \$25/each for chance to win the "Bar"*
      - *Player gets \$20 back per raffle ticket sold to their own Lax Cash Account*

- Player Lax Cash accounts: Players are listed by numbers (for anonymity); send an email to [treasurer@chatfieldlacrosse.com](mailto:treasurer@chatfieldlacrosse.com) if you don't know your son's number
  - King Soopers Rewards: Players can earn 4% back to their Lax Cash account on all King Soopers purchases once signed up. Sign up online; instructions are on our website > About Us > Player Accounts & Fundraising

### **Equipment, Uniforms, Helmets, and Apparel**

- Helmets can be purchased on our website or with cash/check after the meeting. Helmets are \$270 (decals included).
  - *\*\* Helmets must be purchased through Chatfield Booster Club*

- Uniforms: Handed out during the first week of practice. A \$300 deposit will be required before your son can receive his uniform. *This is just a deposit*; we will collect checks from each player and hold them until the end of the season. When ALL pieces of the uniforms are returned clean and undamaged, your check will be returned to you. Any items lost MUST be paid for beyond the deposit fee.
- Cleats and game/practice clothing
  - Cleats: Wear only Chatfield colors (black, white, maroon, grey)
  - Practice clothing: Wear only Chatfield colors (black, white, maroon, grey)
  - Games: Bring all uniform pieces to every game. If cold, players can wear BLACK sweatpants. Hoodies (black, grey, maroon, or white ONLY) can be worn under jerseys.
- Team store is live! Closes November 1 at 10pm. Team and fan apparel including practice and game items needed are for sale on the Mercury Screenprinting website.

### **Miscellaneous Information**

- Physicals are required and must be submitted via Chatfield Athletics' registration portal. Registrations must be accepted by the school before your son can try out. Physical and registration is **due by February 21, 2025**.
  - We will send out communications via email when registration is open.
- Spring Break trip by invitation only (usually past Varsity players)
  - Week of March 17
  - Information/invitations will be sent in November
  - *\*\* Visit a couple of college campuses on Spring Break*
- *\*\* END OF YEAR BANQUET: Date TBD - Player's cost covered with Booster Fee; each additional attendee is \$40/person*

### **Scholarships**
